Vicar's letter

Dear Friends of the Parish of White Waltham with Woodlands Park,

Welcome to September, which may be turning out to be the new normal, where we learn to live with a new virus, or something else entirely?! I pray we are not forced to take any steps backward, and that you stay well and safe. Whatever the current restrictions and patterns are, it has certainly made us take a break from what we were doing back in 2019, (almost certainly we were too busy) and maybe given a chance to rethink the priorities and activities and habits in our lives.

Habits, I've been thinking about our habits... prompted in part by an article written by Alianore Smith for the London Institute of Contemporary Christianity. Maybe you have come across Ed Sheeran's new single 'Bad Habits'? His bad habit of choice isn't nail biting or putting too much into the diary, but an inability to say no – to one-night stands, to alcohol, to strangers' invitations to parties. His bad habits lead to 'late nights, endin' alone / conversations with a stranger I barely know / swearing this will be the last but it probably won't'.

It's song-writing gold: relatable, catchy, and insightful. We all have those things that we can't say no to. We all have those moments where we swear 'this'll be the last time' or 'ooh, last one' (I'm thinking of anything

chocolatey for me), and then find ourselves right back where we started a few days, hours, minutes later.

Now, this isn't new; Paul the apostle wrote on this 2000 years ago. In Romans 7v15-16 Paul writes 'I do not understand what I do. For what I want to do I do not, but what I hate I do'. Maybe Ed Sheeran has been reading him recently? Or perhaps it's more about his insight on human nature: habits form us, for good or ill.

Habits have power. Ed seems resigned to this: 'I was lookin' for a way out, now I can't escape'. But Paul offers us a different answer: 'who will rescue me from this body that is subject to death? Thanks be to God, who delivers me through Jesus Christ our Lord!'

Ed sings about how his 'bad habits lead to you', the 'you' clearly being someone that he knows is bad for him, but he can't stay away from. Paul writes about how our bad habits can lead us to throw ourselves on the mercy of Christ.


People often think that they are not good enough for God – that God would reject them and their sinful, shame-filled, broken selves. But if you know about Jesus, you know that there is the free offer of rescue, and thus we have good news to share. If you don't know about Jesus, please come and ask or get in touch with me, our bad habits and negative self-images can be such life-spoilers.

At church this autumn we are coming back to the basics of who church is, what it is for, and why Jesus and his people are good news – see page 4. If you have ever thought about trying out, or coming back, to church, then September to November is a really good time to do it. Come with questions and experiences and reflections, and choose to come regularly, make this **a new good habit**!

Jesus truly has good news for you; bad habits, although sinful, are never the end of the story. There is grace for all who would turn towards it. And for Christians? Well, our bad habits remind us daily of our need for God.




