

The Light of the World

There is an allegorical painting that is almost as familiar as the verse of scripture that inspired it. I refer to William Holman Hunt's 'The Light of the World'. The original version now hangs in Keble College, Oxford, but there are Engraved reproductions were hung in numerous nurseries, schools and church buildings and it is probably through these that the painting has come to be so widely known. Hunt believed himself, although unworthy, to have responded to a Divine command. His inspiration has brought a Biblical message to the attention of thousands.

The passage of scripture on which the painting is based can be found in Revelation Chap 3 verse 20, where Jesus is quoted "Here I am, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with him and he with me".

Painted around 1849, we are shown Jesus preparing to knock on an overgrown and long unopened door. The door in the painting has no handle – it can only be opened from the inside 'representing the obstinately closed mind'.



In 1905 – 1907 the painting made a world tour, viewed, it is estimated by 80% of Australia's population. It was considered to be the most important and influential rendering of Christ at the time.



Just a Couple of Twigs

As I write, it is a Friday in mid-February and we are coming towards the end of a wonderful week of late summer weather – which reminds me that I need to water the vegetable gardens this evening or everything will dry up and die!

Around eighteen years ago, not that long after we left Woodlands Park to resettle in New Zealand. A neighbour and a friend of ours was given a lovely flower arrangement. As happens, these wilt as time goes by but before our friend threw them out, we asked if we could have a couple of twisted willow twigs that had formed part of the arrangement. Although they looked totally dry and dead, we popped them into a glass of water and were surprised and delighted when we saw that on one of the twigs, tiny roots forming.



After a further period of growth, this twig had grown into a small seedling sized tree, ready and able to be planted out. So we selected a site near the bottom of our garden and planted it out and kept it watered as it grew... and grew... and grew.

Now I am at an age where I am no longer able to deal with removing what has become a very tall tree which is interfering with other garden growth nearby including red and black currants which have had very little fruit this year. Mind you, that could be because our cats are not frightening the birds away sufficiently and so the birds have had several good feeds!

We are very blessed as we have a gentleman in our church who has lots of skills and also lots of appropriate tools as well as a small truck which can use to take away the unwanted greenery. He started last weekend and has already felled the willow and a laurel too.

Tomorrow he will be back to take down another couple of trees that are no longer wanted (one is totally dead!) and so we will finally be rid of our unwanted huge tree which has taken over so much of our garden. I am always amazed at God's provision in that even a small twig can grow into an enormous and very beautiful tree.

As I have been thinking about this in the past few days I have seen that it is also possible for something to be introduced into the garden of our lives where it can take root and grow into something either very beautiful and desirable or something unwanted, dangerous and destructive.

Here's a song I learned many years ago and I hope it is something you will use in your prayers – it really does work!

My heart may be like a garden fair Loving words and thoughts and deeds a-blossoming there. Or it may be a place of poison weeds Growing into ugly words and thoughts and deeds. Lord Jesus make my heart a garden fair, Come thou thyself and be the Gardener there!
