## News from Woodlands Park Primary & Nursery School

This term has seen the children return from their half term holiday with enthusiasm for the run up to Christmas. Even though our usual events have had to be done a little differently, we are still able to celebrate the season. The children created a lovely Harvest Festival Film last term which we put on our website for parents to see. Our families were very generous and donated lots of food which we gave to Susan Brett for Maidenhead Foodshare. The children also enjoyed a super 'Halloween Trail' around the school grounds.

Our Year Six children have been studying the Shakespeare play Macbeth and were due to perform it at Norden Farm in the middle of November. However, due to the Lockdown, they will be rehearsing at school and we will film it for the parents and the rest of the school to see. The show must go on as they say!

The children have also been thinking about Remembrance and each child is making a poppy to lay in our Remembrance Garden on 11<sup>th</sup> November. A commemorative assembly will be held via zoom from my office with the children taking it in turns to lay their poppies in our remembrance garden. We are making good use of our grounds too, using our Forest School area as much as possible enabling the children to stay outside.



The children in Key Stage One are busy preparing for their annual Nativity Play and once again this will be performed in front of a select, socially distanced audience (ie the Office Team!) and filmed for the parents, carers and families to enjoy. Christmas lunch will also be going ahead and the children will be enjoying this in their class bubbles. We have arranged for the children to watch an online pantomime during our forthcoming Christmas Week too!

An exciting new after school facility started this term and the school can now offer wrap around care from 8am to 6pm, including breakfast at our breakfast club and a hot meal at our after school club. The school has joined forces with The Brett Foundation to offer after school care at fantastic price of £6 including a meal.



We still have space in our Nursery Class and can take children from three years old. If you are in receipt of Two Year Old Funding, we have a small number of places available for two year old children. If you have any questions regarding this, please do call the school office on 01628 822350.



Dear Friends of the Parish of White Waltham with Woodlands Park,  
Hello and Happy Autumn to you!

*Since this was written we have entered a 2<sup>nd</sup> lockdown so some plans have had to be speedily updated...!*

I hope and pray you find that these issues of Community News are helping you to stay informed and in touch, even in these strange, isolated times, and it has been great to hear from a range of bodies and individuals.

Since I last wrote here at Community News, we have had a successful **return to meeting in person at church** (*and are very sad about the latest lockdown news*). Although there has been social distancing including one-way systems, wearing of masks, lack of singing, and enough sanitiser to swim in, we have, I think, had a good time back together. Some need to stay away, so the service is streamed live and recorded for watching later in the week from our website. If you are watching please let us know!


# Service of Remembrance & Thanksgiving

Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> November


This quiet, reflective service provides the opportunity for us to remember loved ones, and to give thanks for all that they did for us while discovering the difference that Jesus makes.




