## News from White Waltham Parish Council

At the time of writing this article, England is in its second lockdown and due to Covid 19 the parish council has concentrated on delivering essential services such as the maintenance of our play areas and open spaces. However, there was one project that had started before coronavirus became an everyday word which needed to be finished. Woodlands Park was the only ward within the parish of White Waltham that didn't have a war memorial so in 2019 the parish council installed a memorial bench and lone soldier at the Woodlands Park Village Centre where it was hoped that residents who might find it difficult to get to other war memorials would like somewhere to sit, reflect and pay their respects. In December 2019 the parish council, with external funding, commissioned four memorial slabs, representing each of the armed forces, to go around the base of the soldier.



On Remembrance Sunday members of the parish council laid a wreath in remembrance of the fallen and during the following week a number of local residents came to pay their respects and leave a small cross in memory of someone close.

Hopefully, next year we can all come together to pay our respects but, in the meantime, please keep safe.

The words therefore represent a call to praise God without reserve.
