# What do you worry about?

Oh dear, I am really having some difficulty deciding how to write about what is on my heart.

I want to tell you a little about my mother-in-law who lives in Devon. She is in her early 90s and has lived a very full life. She was an only child but gave birth to 6 children. One of these, a little boy became very sick before he was old enough to go to school. Sadly or perhaps not so sadly, he passed away. Already he had been told about Jesus and had accepted him as his Saviour. That is why I say “perhaps not so sadly” as all his family members, even those he never met, are all sure they will see him in heaven.

My mother-in-law brought up the remaining five to also know the Lord Jesus and accept him for themselves. Her life has not been easy, but she is an accomplished musician with a glorious singing voice and the ability to play keyboard instruments at a high standard and as a way of earning a little money, she has taught a large number of people to play the piano.

At our wedding, she played the piano and certainly added to the joy of that occasion. As you know, we now live here in New Zealand and since coming home in 2000, my mother-in-law has suffered several bereavements, her father, her husband and no doubt many of her friends too. And now she is extremely ill herself.

Before she got so ill, she wrote a living will in which she expressed the wish that her life should not be artificially maintained but that she should be allowed to pass away peacefully. Sadly, that wish has not been granted and she has spent time in hospital, then in a Rest Home and now she is back in hospital. She cannot see, she cannot hear and so her life right now appears to have no meaning.

All she wants is to be able to pass away and wake up in heaven to meet her Lord and all the friends and family who are already there and that includes my parents and my younger brother too.

Do you worry about your own end? Where will you spend eternity? Many people put off such thoughts saying that they’ll think about death when they “get old”. I have the same faith she had knowing that my future in heaven is absolutely guaranteed on the basis of what God has told us in His Word.

So to close, what do you worry about? If you trust the Lord Jesus to forgive the wrong things you’ve done, like my mother-in-law, like me and like every Christian, you’ll never need to worry about where you will be five minutes after you pass away – you’ll be in heaven for all eternity. And that means we’ll have the joy of meeting each other.




